Throughout this experience, fellows of diverse backgrounds will embark on an immersive two weeks of learning in the heart of American diplomacy, Washington, DC.

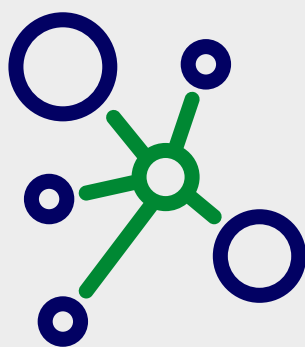
The program will include captivating and informative visits to various organizations and institutions throughout our nation's capitol.

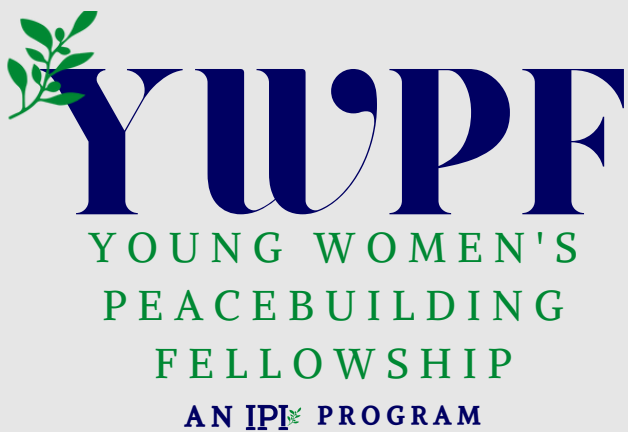
WHAT WE DO

OUR IMPACT

Over the last decade, IPI has developed sustainable peacebuilding efforts around the world. IPI has accompanied peacebuilding in: Iraq (Kurdistan), Afghanistan, Uganda, Burundi and the DRC. Most recently, our work has included the demobilization and reintegration of child soldiers and other active militia members in the DRC while working with Congolese peacebuilding leaders.
